The central celebration of the core Christian message and the point of the entire Christian year is the THREE-day celebration of HOLY THURSDAY (Mass of the Lord's Supper) **7:00 pm**; GOOD FRIDAY (Liturgy of the Passion) **7:00 pm**; and the EASTER VIGIL **7:15 pm** (begins with the lighting of the Easter Fire)
